Key conclusion 1	Unawareness of abuses of honour related violence, and how to recognise the indicators. Participants do not know where to signpost individuals who need further information and support.
Key conclusion 2	Unawareness of the legal recourse available to victims and support and guidance for potential victims. Lack of knowledge regarding multi-agency working, and where to turn for specialist knowledge and support for practitioners.
Key conclusion 3	Reluctance to engage with honour related abuse due to fear of making mistakes, or being labelled as racist or discriminatory.
